This award is for all of us, once again congratulations!!!

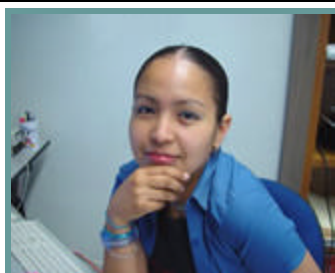

- Facts and statistics of the e-learning.

E-learning growing in the organizations.

The corporate market of e-learning in the United States grows quickly and it is no longer restricted to its technological origins. While in the past, the training in technologies of information (IT), was the strong topic of the corporate e-learning- 76% concentrated in 2000- now the industry moves quickly toward other areas. In the 2005, 58. 8% of the e-learning market will be concentrated in the development of abilities for business and other abilities not related with IT. But it doesn't mean, certainly, that the IT training market is decreasing. Instead, the IT training will represent a smaller proportion than a bigger market, which will grow from \$2,300 million dollars in the 2000 to \$18,000 million dollars in the 2005. BETTER USE OF THE ENERGY AND THE GLOBAL HEATING: Internet is transforming the United States into a country taking more efficiently advantage of its energy resources, reducing the gases' emission produced by the hothouse effect and they increase the global heating when weakening the ozone layer. In 1997 as in 1998 the necessary quantity of energy to produce a dollar was 4%, the biggest decrease in 50 years. (Center for Energy & Climate Solutions, Dec. 1999).
